



## Gift Aid Declaration

### What is Gift-Aid?

Gift Aid is a government programme that allows charities to claim back tax on donations.

With Gift Aid, we receive an additional 25 pence from the HM Revenue & Customs for every pound received through a donation.

For example, through Gift Aid, your donation of £10 automatically becomes £12.50.

To have your donation go further using Gift Aid, please complete this form and return it to us.

To qualify for Gift Aid, what you pay in income tax or capital gains tax must at least equal the amount we will claim in the tax year.
